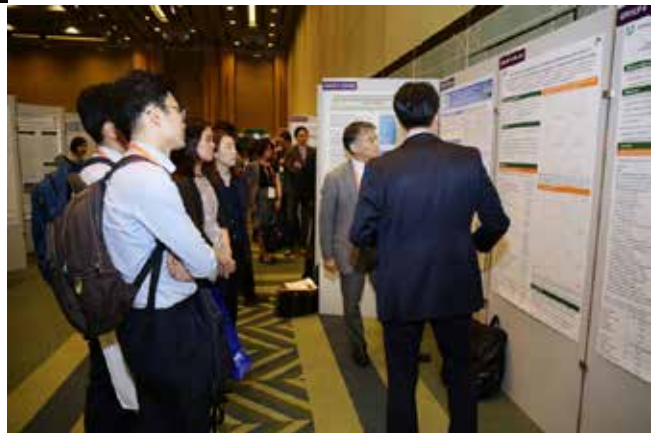



We look forward to seeing you all in Shanghai.


