Dear all members and colleagues of the AOCC,



1) Overview

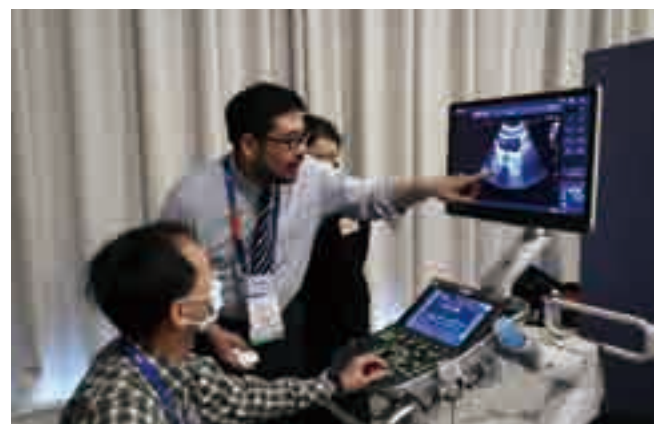

Awardee: Jun Miyoshi, M.D., Ph.D.

Although I needed to postpone my visit to Städtisches Klinikum Lüneburg due to a global COVID-19 outbreak, I could finally visit and have an intestinal ultrasound (IUS) training there in August-September 2022. I thank everyone for supporting this great opportunity.

The purpose of my visit was to learn IUS for inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) in daily practice in Europe. Today ECCO and International Bowel Ultrasound (IBUS) Group collaborate and lead the field of IBS-IUS. Since we also started IBD-IUS in our facility, I would have liked to learn about the current situation as well as the IUS techniques and training system in the leading facility. During this visit, I realized that IBD-IUS is commonly used as a point-of-care manner in the clinical setting and contributes to clinical decision-making. I also could experience many IBD-IUS cases with educational feedback. I appreciate the mentorship and friendship of supervisors and colleagues in Lüneburg.
